928.01 <u>DEFINITIONS</u>

- a) LIGHT DUTY RESCUE FEE Circumstances requiring traffic control, control of small fluid leaks, vehicle stabilization, accident scene safety use of minor tools, patient care and stabilization.
- b) HEAVY DUTY RESCUE Circumstances requiring hydraulic equipment or specialized rescue techniques to aid patient or circumstances requiring the assistance of another fire unit.
- c) INDUSTRIAL COMMERCIAL RESPONSE Circumstances carried out in an industrial or commercial setting, spills involving hazardous material, rescues that require additional specialized equipment above that required for fire response.
- d) DESTROYED OR CONTAMINATED EQUIPMENT Any equipment that is destroyed or contaminated at the rescue or response scene.

928.03 <u>BILLING OF FIRE INSPECTION-CODE ENFORCEMENT NONCOMPLIANCE FEES.</u>

The noncompliance fee shall be the hourly inspector's salary rate multiplied by the number of hours expended in re-inspections after the Fire/Life Safety order has been issued (2 hour minimum) and shall be paid by the owner. The first re-inspection after the Fire/Life Safety order has been issued will not be charged to the owner if the property is in compliance at the time of that re-inspection. If the property is not in compliance at the time of the first re-inspection, then time involved in all subsequent re-inspections shall be chargeable as a noncompliance fee.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
