ATTENTION NIAGARA COUNTY HOMEOWNERS

Niagara Community Action Program, Inc. is pleased to announce the availability of grant funds for accessibility modifications to qualified Niagara County residents who own their home.

The types of modifications can include:

- Ramps, lifts, and other similar measures to permit access to existing residential housing units from the exterior of the building.
- Kitchen and bathroom modifications in existing residential units to provide access to persons with mobility limitations or disabling conditions.
- Interior accessibility modifications to existing residential units that will permit access within the unit for persons with mobility limitations or other disabling conditions.
- Devices to permit use of an existing home by persons with hearing or visual impairments.

The scope of work and amount of financial assistance will be determined by an inspection of the home. Homeowners must meet income eligibility guidelines and other program criteria.
