

RESOLUTION No. 2022-

***RELATIVE TO THE PARTIAL ABANDONMENT OF THE ALLEY BETWEEN VIRGINIA AVENUE AND TENNESSEE AVENUE***

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Niagara Falls desires to abandon a portion of the alley running east-west between Tennessee Avenue and Virginia Avenue in order to facilitate utilization of the alley by abutting property owners; and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Board of the City of Niagara Falls at its meeting on May 4, 2022 recommended that the City Council approve the abandonment of a portion of the aforementioned alley (on file in the City Clerk's Office); and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council did, by resolution, give notice of its intention to abandon a portion of the aforementioned alley and did direct the City Clerk to publish notice of such intention and that a public hearing would be held by the City Council at its meeting to be held in the Council Chambers on June 22, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. daylight savings time and advise that all persons interested would be heard thereon at that said time and place; and

**WHEREAS**, the hearing was duly held on June 22, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. daylight savings time in regard to said abandonment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Niagara Falls, New York that a portion of the alley running east-west between Tennessee Avenue and Virginia Avenue is hereby abandoned. The said alley portion is bounded and described as follows:

The area constituting the westerly most 72.10 feet as measured along the northerly right-of-way boundary, with an approximate area of 800 40 square feet (0.0192 acres).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any deeds or other documents desirable to effectuate this abandonment; and
