**RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED
ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION OF SECOND STREET (WHIRLPOOL STREET)
NORTH OF WALNUT AVENUE**

WHEREAS, there has been a request relative to abandonment of a no longer utilized portion of the Second Street north of Walnut Avenue; and

WHEREAS, this former roadway was removed and converted to parkland by the New York State Department of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation during the removal of the Niagara Scenic Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation has requested abandonment of this now unused 66 foot-wide by 2000 foot-long street as it will develop this area in a manner consistent with parks and maintain the same conducive to a schedule which will enhance the experience of visitors to the park area; and

WHEREAS, relevant City Departments have reviewed the proposed abandonment request and approves of the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby declares its intention to abandon the above street, as described above.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that public hearing be held on abandonment of the aforementioned portion of the Second Street north of Walnut Avenue at a meeting of the City Council to be held on Wednesday, December 14, 2022, at 6:00 o'clock P.M. and the City Clerk is hereby directed to publish a notice of intention to discontinue and abandon the above-mentioned portion of the street in the Niagara Gazette once a week for two (2) successive weeks preceding December 14, 2022.
