RE: Transfer of Surplus Police Vehicles to the Town of Youngstown

Council Members:

The City of Niagara Falls currently possesses two (2) vehicles previously utilized by the Niagara Falls Police Department (“NFPD”) which are no longer needed and which the City wishes to declare as surplus property. Vehicle #1 is a 2017 Ford Explorer with an odometer reading of 121,385 miles; Vehicle #2 is 2016 Ford Explorer with an odometer reading 122,931 miles. The initial plan was that both of these vehicles would be auctioned by the City as surplus property, however the NFPD has become aware that the Village of Youngstown Police Department is in urgent need of additional police vehicles in the performance of their duties. In furtherance of public safety and in the spirit of law enforcement cooperation in Niagara County, it is hereby proposed that the City transfer both of the aforementioned vehicles, in “as is” condition, to the Village of Youngstown. The City has been the recipient of similar transfers in the past and it is therefore recommended that the City Council approve such a transfer.

Will the Council vote to approve and authorize the Mayor to execute any documents necessary to effectuate the same?
