## 2. <u>Certificate of Appropriateness – 822 Cleveland Avenue</u>

Applicant Niagara University is seeking a Certificate of Appropriateness to rehabilitate the former First Congregationalist Church at 822 Cleveland Avenue (S.B.L. 144.46-1-52). Repairs include exterior masonry work, replacement of some existing windows, and the addition of a new entry to accommodate Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements.

Tom Yots of Preservation Studios, working on behalf of Niagara University, gave a history of the First Congregationalist Church, explained the project scope, and described Niagara University's goal to turn the building into a workforce training center while preserving worship space for the congregation.

Daniel MacMann of Niagara University explained the restoration process and what needed to be done to make the project viable.

Joseph Rudniski of LaBella Associates also explained the design and the construction process. Mr. Rudniski explained that one of the major moves was to transfer a fireplace to a different location for space reasons. He said that the fireplace was not original to the church.
